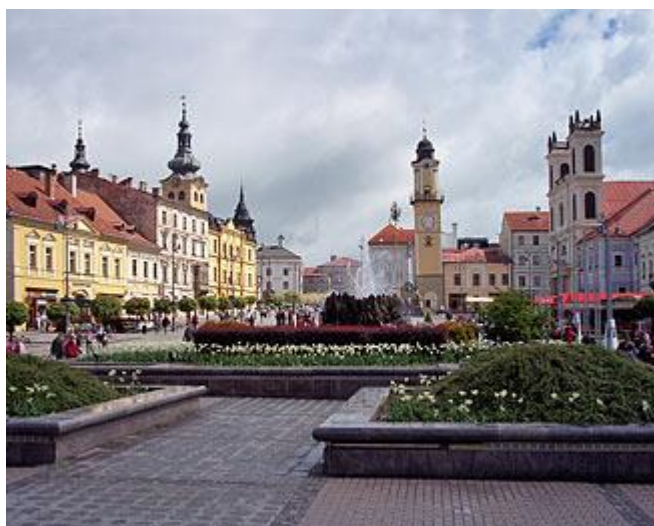

The aim of the conference

A typical feature of the society at the beginning of 21st century is a gradual decline of the influence of norm-giving institutions as well as the fact that the society has to solve more and more complex ethical dilemmas. The results of scientific research have opened discussion on previously unknown situations and search for alternatives of ethical solutions. This state of affairs is an urgent challenge for the whole world.

The forthcoming conference will contribute to this discussion about the ethical dimensions of human behaviour. We will try to answer the question if using Christian analyses and arguments in the Bible - God's revealed world, in creation order, in Judeo-Christian traditions, in rational utilitarian considerations, could answer the deep longings/anxieties of the people? To the analyses of Christian theologians we would like to invite partners from other scientific areas (philosophy, psychology, sociology, economics and political sciences).

Papers should be written in English and be a maximum of 10 000 words:

TITLE OF PAPER [Times New Roman 14 point, bold, centred]

Author Name(s) [Times New Roman, 12 point, bold, centred]

Name of Institution [10 point, normal, centred]

City /Country [10 point, normal, centred]

E-mail [10 point, italic, centred]

Abstract [Times New Roman-point, bold, centred]

The text of the abstract should be a maximum of 500 words and written in italicized text, using Times New Roman 10-point. The paragraph should be centered; Leave two blank lines after the abstract, then begin the main text.

The main body of the text should be written using the **Times New Roman 10-point** font and single spacing. Please do not place any additional blank lines between paragraphs.

All margins should be set at 2.5 cm

The citation number of a bibliographical reference in text must be enclosed in square brackets, for example [1]. A list of the references should be given at the end of the paper.

Figures, tables and graphics should be centred, numbered and accompanied by a legend. (Fig.1. Legend, Table 1.Legend). Where possible Times New Roman 10-point should be used for all figures, tables and graphics

Please, avoid using page numbers, headers and footnotes.

1. First-order headings

For example, “**1. Introduction**”, should be **Times New Roman 12-point** boldface, initially capitalized

1.2 Second-order headings

They should be **Times New Roman 11-point** boldface, initially capitalized
